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- ... but many components running on phones are usually proprietary
 - some components are always proprietary:
 - almost everything in app "stores"
 - modem driver
 - Wifi driver?
 - Bluetooth driver?



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- The high-level part of the system and apps are written in Java
 - Huge, complicated, slow build system;
 - at least the build system runs on GNU/Linux.

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
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



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Free software on cell phones: Replicant



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- Can we liberate Android?
 - Remove proprietary parts
 - Ideally, replace what was removed with some free-software rewrite

Almost: every modem is proprietary, and difficult to reverse-engineer.

• However in many cases modems are isolated: they do not make the rest of the system insecure.



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- An app "store" with only free-software apps: f-droid
- You can spend a long time installing apps and (to a limited degree) customising

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
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
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
Reboot and recovery mode

Some I actually use; a few are silly, some I have just tried once.



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


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Web browsing




GNU Jami works well, and is a complex application. (Recommended).




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

More apps should be free!

It is very frustrating that, for example, public transport apps are proprietary.

We should insist that organisations release the plain data: we as a community can write good apps ourselves.

A friendly attendee wanted to help people coming to Izmir for the GHM, but we found no way of using one specific form of public transportation without a proprietary app. (This is **not** specific to Izmir or Turkey)
